



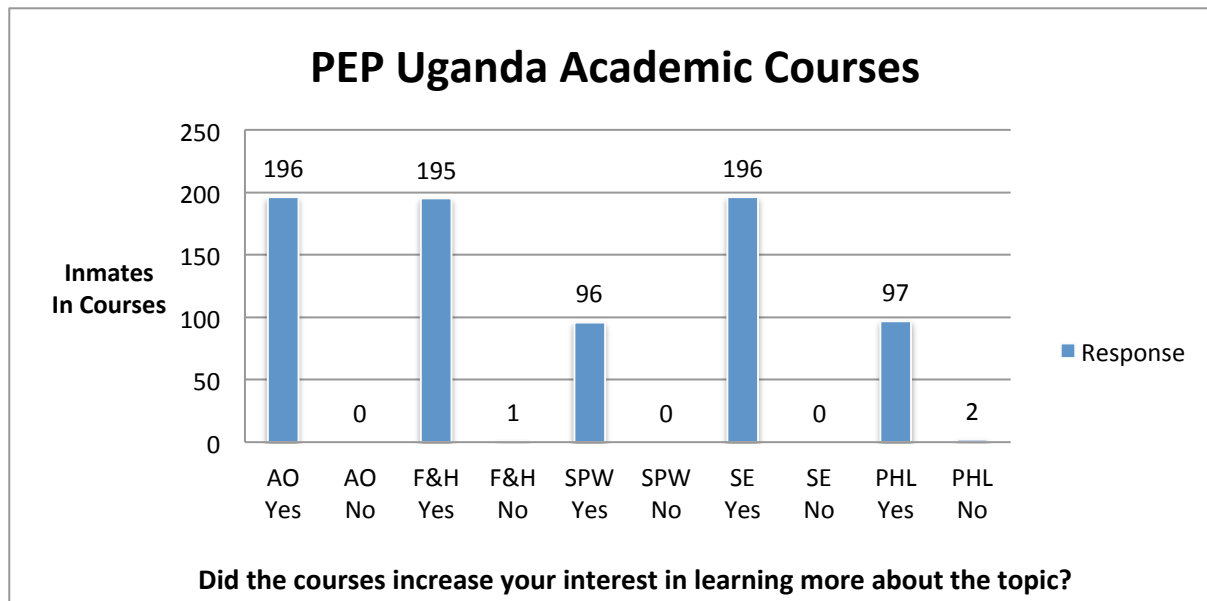
Prison Education Project-Uganda

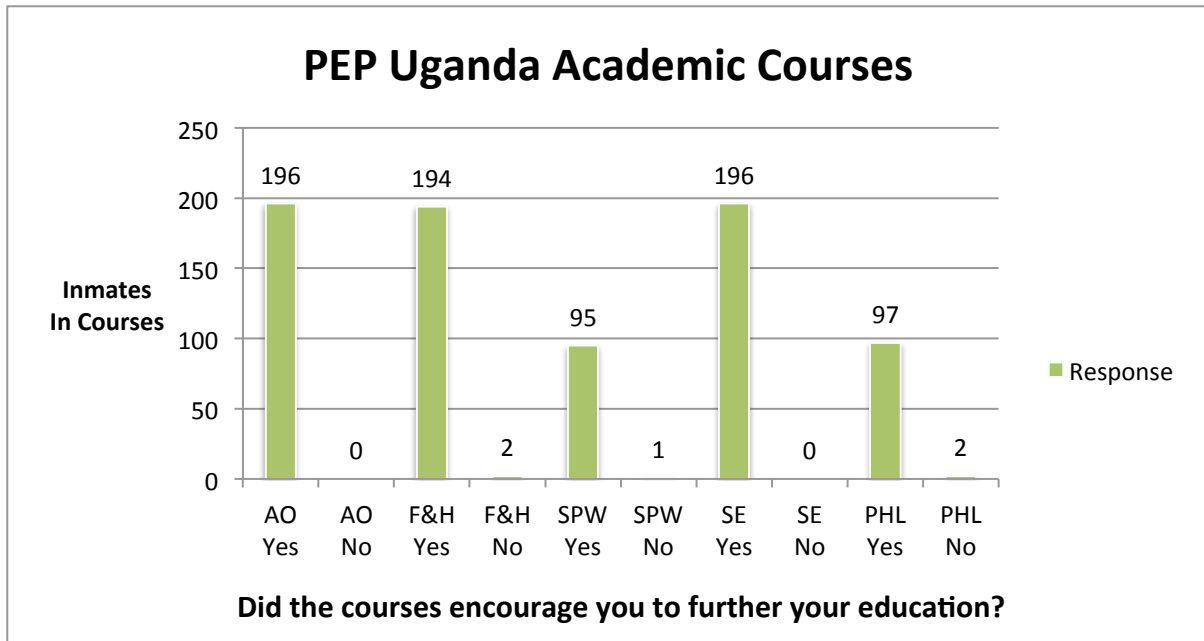
**Narrative Responses**

- The strength of the program has been to encourage us always, not to lose hope, and to be good people.

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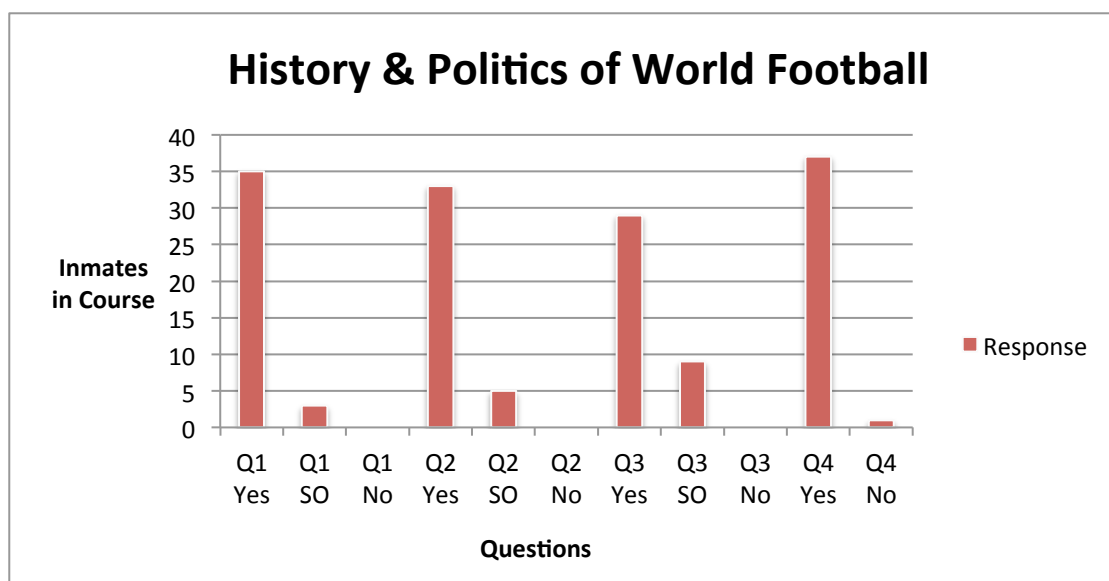
### Narrative Responses
